### **MACARTHUR GRADUATE INTERN: 1 MARCH – 31 AUGUST, 2008**

The Faculty of Law, University of Ibadan is interested in employing four graduate interns under the John D and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation Grant for Capacity Building in the Faculty of Law. The internship will be for a period of nine months, commencing from 1 March, 2008.

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons who graduated in Law within the last two years with not less than a Second Class Upper Degree (2<sup>1</sup>). Graduation from the Nigerian Law School will be an added advantage.

Intern will be given a monthly stipend, an office, and youth corper accommodation within the University of Ibadan.

Successful interns will be expected to be involved in research, tutorials, and minimal administrative activities under the tutelage of Senior Academic Staff, so that they will be fully exposed to academic pursuits. They will be exposed to international research-related travel and will be eligible for consideration for a scholarship for the Master of Laws Degree of the Faculty.

The ideal candidate should be very bright, resourceful, and willing to take the initiative when necessary. He/she should like research and be willing to pursue a career in academia. Computer proficiency is imperative as is the ability to undertake research on the internet.

Interested applicants should submit 3 copies of an application letter together with a detailed Curriculum Vitae, addressed to **'The Dean, Faculty of Law, University of Ibadan'** with **'MACARTHUR INTERN'** written on the top left hand corner of the envelope. The deadline for the submission of applications is 8 February, 2008.

**Shortlisted applicants will be contacted and invited for interviews on 21– 22 February, 2008.**
