7. UNDP HIV/AIDS RESEARCH GRANT: 3RD ANNOUNCEMENT

The UNDP has provided a small research grant for senior undergraduate or graduate student research in HIV and AIDS from the Social Sciences point of view. The beneficiaries should be in the top 20 percent of their class for undergraduate students and among the top 50 percent for graduate students. Proposals are invited from students who fulfill the above criteria and are currently conducting such research.
