COMMITTEE ON GUIDELINES AND CONDITIONS FOR AWARD OF SENATE RESEARCH GRANTS: CALL FOR MEMORANDA.

At its meeting of 17 January 2007, the Research Grants Sub-Committee of the Development Committee observed that, over the years, the process of awarding Senate Research Grants to applicants had not been guided by a permanent set of basic rules,. In addition, it was observed that a system to monitor the execution of research funded by Senate has not been put in place beyond controls instituted by the Bursary.

To address these issues, the Sub-Committee decided to set up a Committee to help develop a set of guidelines and conditions for awarding the grants in a manner that will maximize transparency and speed,. Also, the Committee is expected to recommend a system for monitoring the execution of research funded by Senate. The Committee has now commenced its assignment.
