The Department of Crop Protection and Environmental Biology (formerly known as the Department of Agricultural Biology), University of Ibadan will be celebrating its Golden Jubilee Anniversary in 2012. The Department of Agricultural Biology was created in 1962 as one of the four departments which developed from the then one department Faculty of Agriculture founded in 1949. The concept then, strange at that time, was, and still remains, an integrated multidisciplinary approach to the application of biology to agriculture and the improvement of productivity in agriculture. This concept has since caught on nationwide. Since 1962, many students have graduated at all levels (BSc, MSc, MPhil & Phd) and are admirably holding their own in their varied endeavours. Several activities have been planned for the Golden Jubilee Celebrations. These include, amongst others, an Anniversary Lecture, a Grand Home-Coming (Reunion), Exhibitions, Publication of a Souvenir Anniversary Brochure, Production and Sale of Anniversary souvenirs, Dinner/Award Night, etc. In addition, a Five Hundred Million Naira (N500 million) GOLDEN JUBILEE FUND has been set up to raise the amount (N500 million) between now and January 2012. # (19) VC ATTENDS NUC CONSULTATIVE MEETING ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP STUDY CENTRES IN NIGERIAN UNIVERSITIES

The Honourable Minister of Education, Prof. Ruqayyatu Ahmed Rufa'i OON has directed all Universities in Nigeria to build Entrepreneurship Study Centres.

She gave the directive at a Consultative meeting of the Vice-Chancellors of Nigerian Universities held in Abuja to deliberate on the establishment of Entrepreneurship Study Centres in Nigerian Universities.

Prof. Rufa'i stated that by the approval of the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, Dr. Goodluck Ebele Jonathan, GCFR, the directive would be supported by the 2011 ETF grants when the meeting sought to know where funds would come from.

The meeting which was held at the Idris Abdulkadir Auditorium of the NUC was well attended. There were about 100 Vice-Chancellors, the Executive Secretaries of the NUC, ETF, NDE, NBTE and NCCE.

The Vice-Chancellor, Prof. I.F. Adewole shared with the meeting, the University of Ibadan's wealth of experience on entrepreneurship education which dates as far back as 2002.

Prof. Adewole attributed the success of the project, in part, to the support from the MacArthur Foundation. He therefore advised that seed grants be provided for institutions towards the realization of the vision.

Meanwhile, the Director of the UI Centre for Entrepreneurship and Innovation, Prof. Gbemisola Oke, has been appointed as a member of the Committee for the Entrenchment of Entrepreneurship Education in all Nigerian Universities. The Vice-Chancellor, while thanking the Honourable Minister and the Executive Secretary of the NUC for this appointment, recognized it as a mark of honour for the University of Ibadan and pledged the University's support for the appointee to ensure that the committee derives maximum benefit from her participation

# Meanwhile a communiqué has been issued by the consultative meeting on the Establishment of Entrepreneurship Study Centres in Nigerian Universities.

The communiqué was signed by the Executive Secretary, National Universities Commission, Prof. J.A Okojie.

**Declaration:** we, the participants at the one-day consultative meeting of the Honourable Minister of Education with Vice-Chancellors, other distinguished stakeholders convened to discuss issues on the establishment of Entrepreneurship Study Centres declare as follows:

Having **noted** the Federal Government's directives in making entrepreneurship education compulsory to students of ALL tertiary institutions in Nigeria and other efforts towards entrenching entrepreneurial culture so as to produce self-reliant graduates relevant to national development;

**Welcome** and **commend** the efforts of the Universities in complying with the directives of government in that regard;

**Recognize** the fact that most of the Universities are offering entrepreneurial courses for all students irrespective of their areas of specialization without a centre:

**Appreciating** the enormous challenges facing the government and the Universities in putting up conducive learning environment towards entrenching entrepreneurial culture amongst its undergraduate students **resolved** as follows;

- i) Entrepreneurship Study Centres will be established in all Universities before the end of the year;
- ii) Establishment of stand alone B.sc degree programme in entrepreneurship studies would commence effective from 2011/2012 academic session:
- iii) Mainstreaming entrepreneurial approach in curriculum delivery across all disciplines;
- iv) Engaging the private sector in building entrepreneurial capacity of student;
- v) University academics to engage more in applied research so as to remain relevant in the world of knowledge economy;
- vi) Robust capacity building programs for staff;
- vii) Entrepreneurship should be developed across all disciplines, noting for instance that Theatre Arts has generated self employment among its graduates with resounding success;

- viii) Universities need to linked up with local industries for commercialization of research findings;
- ix) There must be a connect between Entrepreneurship Study Centres and Universities Counseling Centres including the appointment of dedicated Entrepreneurship Counselors within the University counseling unit:
- x) Universities must forge closer relationship with their host communities in order to boost the emergence of local industries;
- xi) Government should empower graduands with soft loans; Adopted this day, 27th January, 2011
