8. **UNIVERSITY HEALTH SERVICE: MOBILE BLOOD DONATION SERVICES AND YEARLY MEDICAL SCREENING**

The Hematology Department of the College of Medicine, will be carrying out screening of staff and students on a monthly basis for HIV 1 & 2 and Hepatitis B & C on **interested voluntary blood donors** at the University Health Service (UHS) with effect from 15 January, 2009 at 10.00 a.m. The Mobile Blood Donation Services in the UHS, will also entail routine counseling and Hemoglobin level and phenotype determination and blood grouping. Interested donors would be between 16 and 65 years of age.

As part of the ongoing effort to stem the tide of HIV/AIDS, interested members of the Community are welcome to see the Matron in charge, Public Health or Principal Medical Social Worker in the UHS for some available materials at no cost.

Staff members are reminded and encouraged to avail themselves of the yearly Medical Screening also at the UHS, as early detection and management of ailment will forestall long term complications and sudden death! Screening for HIV and Hepatitis B virus is also available.
