## **SECURITY ALERT**

As the Christmas and New Year festivities are approaching, there is the need to remind the University community to adhere to minimum security measures, which have been severally highlighted through this medium. Also, the dry season, which could be hazardous if not well managed, is approaching.

In the light of these developments, and for the sake of emphasis, some security measures that could guide staff and students are hereby stated as follows:

- (a) **Bush Burning**: Bush burning should be avoided during the dry season as this could lead to unimaginable inferno and could be destructive. Security Office should be alerted immediately in case of fire outbreak.
- (b) **Fire Crackers/Bangers/Explosives**: During the approaching festivities and dry season, fireworks, crackers and explosives should be avoided. In fact, these devices have long been banned by the Nigeria Police. Whoever indulges in the use of fireworks during these festivities would be arrested and prosecuted.
- (c) **Campus Residents**: Campus residents are advised to ensure that their doors and windows are firmly locked before going to bed. The habit of opening doors and windows to take fresh air while sleeping should be avoided.
- (d) **Electrical Appliances**: During the festivities and dry season period, electrical appliances should be switched off when not in use.
- (e) **Suspicious Movements**: Residents on Campus should alert the Security Office in case of any suspicious movements in their areas.
- (f) **Emergencies**: In case of emergencies, please call the Security Office immediately and please check the University Official Bulletins for contact telephone numbers of the Security Office.
